Dear participating members,

Thank you for your continued support and participation in the Alberta Municipalities High Interest Savings Account (HISA). We are pleased to report to you that the interest rate for our HISA has increased to 3.05%. This reflects the recent decision made by the Bank of Canada to increase the Canada prime rate by 1%.

Effective July 14, 2022, participating members will be earning 3.05% (CWB Prime 4.70% - 1.65%) on their HISA deposits.

Many of our members use this savings vehicle to earn interest on daily cash on hand, deferred capital project financing, and grant funding. We are proud to offer this in partnership with Canadian Western Bank (CWB) and the Government Finance Officers Association of Alberta (GFOA), as it affirms our commitment to serve communities, not shareholders.


